## **GUIDELINES**

- 1. Treat others how you want to be treated.
- 2. All electronics to be silenced or turned off during teachings and small group.
- 3. Stay in authorized areas.
- 4. Public displays of affection while at church functions are inappropriate. This includes "hanging on" someone, excessive hugging, hand-holding, kissing, sharing a seat, or other obviously "romantic" behavior.
- 5. No Profanity
- 6. Respect the facilities (e.g., do not throw or kick balls at the doors or walls; no standing, walking, or running on furniture or chairs; clean up after yourself)
- 7. Dress Code:

It is important that our dress is appropriate. It is our intention to be holy and pleasing to God. Clothing should not be disruptive or bring unnecessary attention to the wearer.

## The following will not be permitted:

- i. Bare midriffs, spaghetti straps, tank tops, see through clothing, tube tops, halter tops.
- ii. Visible undergarments. Pants should be worn at waist/hip level.

- iii. Dresses, skirts, shorts, skorts and garments that are shorter than the wearer's fingertips with the arm and hand fully extended. If a garment has a slit, the top of the slit must be lower than the wearer's fingertips with the arms and hand fully extended.
- iv. No clothing with offensive or obscene pictures and/or words.

If you would not wear it to church on Sunday morning or to school, then chances are you should not wear it to youth group. Should you dress in an inappropriate manner you will be asked to put on different clothes or your parents will be called to bring you different clothing or to take you home.

Disruptive or unsafe behavior will not be tolerated. Disruptive and unsafe behavior includes any violation of the Youth Encounter Guideline. The final authority determining what is and is not considered disruptive and unsafe behavior will be the Youth Director. If your behavior is deemed disruptive or unsafe your parents will be called to come to the event and take you home.
